The modular wood wall system CRAFTWAND®, made of solid beech wood modules, helps design residential environments, creates ambiences and emphasizes architectural concepts of all kinds. Inside the massive wood wall hides an invisible fastening solution which is registered for patent approval.

Constance, 08.11.2017 Fully using the potential of wood as a natural resource, minimizing waste during manufacturing – this was the original idea when CRAFTWAND® has been developed. Creating a product that is highly aesthetic and at the same time flexibly applicable was equally important. The result is a modular wood wall system made of solid beech wood blocks which entices with a clear and purist design language.

Thanks to the easy installation solution, using only dowel pins and screws, CRAFTWAND® can be constructed, dismantled and reconstructed in a very short time with simple tools. With a cross-section size of 150 x 150 mm, the standard modules are available in different length-formats and can be built wall-to-wall, floor-to-ceiling or as low partitions connected to the floor and/or to a main wall. CRAFTWAND® can be installed in various shapes for dividing purposes: T-shape style, Z-shape, U-shape, or L-shape. Modules with additional features, for example embedded cable ducts and special cut-outs, combine functionality with pure aesthetics.

The system can be fitted in various environments such as residential, commercial, hospitality, or corporate set-ups.

The first major project has been realized in London. Together with Hassell Studio, CRAFTWAND® designed work and meeting spaces for Sky Central, improving quality of stay for its occupants, staff and visitors alike.

The recently opened CRAFTWAND® showroom in Constance appears aesthetically minimal and it is definitely worth seeing. Sited in an old church, St. Johann, the system and its many versatile applications can be experienced there.

CRAFTWAND® will soon be presented at WAF – the World Architecture Festival Berlin (Booth C50) taking place on 15-17th November.
